## Childhood

Fiona was born to **Pavik** and **Tyria Ralle** on Corellia's Vreni Island. A year or so after Fiona's birth, Tyria became Chief of Staff to Corellia's representative to the Galactic Senate, **Jorus Malo**, and Pavik retired from his position as a Corellian Security Force (CorSec) Tactical Responder to spend more time with Fiona.

Pavik and Fiona would often travel to and from Coruscant so the family could be together when the Senate was in session, and it was on those trips that Fiona started to show an affinity for computers and technology, even being able to re-program a cleaning droid that had malfunctioned when she was four. From there, she tinkered with most things she could get her hands on, eventually escalating to the family protocol droid when she was seven.

(Her father called her '**Sticks**' for the first time after that incident, catching her hiding in a closet with the remote control she used to manually control the droid. The nickname stuck with her; it eventually became the name she went by in her dealings with **The Vortex** and the rest of the Coruscant underground.)

About a year after that incident, Fiona and Pavik had just returned to Corellia after one of their visits with Tyria where they got the news that there had been an attempt on Jorus' life, but it had failed and instead killed Tyria and another five members of the staff. Jorus had been outspoken about the need to keep the Galactic Senate around, and while no one claimed responsibility for the attack, it was widely rumored to a group with Pro-Imperial ties.

Eight-year-old Fiona was dealt another blow six months later, as her father was kidnapped by an unknown group. Sent to live at a Corellian orphanage, she continued to hone her technical skills, orchestrating a jail break of sorts for herself when she was sixteen.

## The Vortex

After breaking out of the orphanage, Fiona stowed aboard a ship heading to Coruscant to begin her quest for answers about her mother's death and father's disappearance. She found the slicer group The Vortex almost immediately after she managed to take down most of the **Coruscant News Network**, and, impressed with her hack of the CNN, they invited her to join; promising access and a family of sorts.

Fiona, along with The Vortex, continued their virtual 'smash and grab' heists almost weekly, focusing on mainly news networks. After a few months, frustrated with the lack of progress she was making into her parents, she began to look into her father's dealings inside CorSec. He had dealt mainly with the **Corellian underworld**, and the increasing influence of **galactic crime syndicates** in the system, which led her into digitally infiltrating Galactic Senate files when she was seventeen.

Once they found out she had been stealing this information, Vortex leadership wanted to sell the information back to the Republic in return for not leaking the information to the public or the Rebel Alliance, but Fiona defied them by copying all the information and passing it onto the Alliance anyway. After another two and a half years of that, her Alliance contact realized she was in danger because of her rogue status, got her off Coruscant and finally in with the Rebel Alliance.

### *Time At Pasture*

Fiona spent most of her time after joining the Rebel Alliance bouncing from secret base to secret base, until one mission where she arrived at **Pasture**. Alliance intelligence operatives would come and go, and the place was run on a skeleton crew and then some, making it the perfect place to conduct research on the names and places that kept coming up in her search to find who killed her mother and kidnapped her father. This is where she would also meet **Derick Ralt**.

He was three years older than she was, with similar origin stories. An intelligence analyst, he was always looking for the opportunity to take his skills out into the field, which he did on various occasions in the Mid Rim. He would help her sort through the mountains of data she would mine from various sources and should assist in outfitting the team with gadgets and technology to aid in their missions. He'd also spend time training with her, with various weapons or hand to hand combat to help develop skills outside of her normal wheelhouse

In those many, many late nights and early mornings, Fiona, after spending years keeping other people at arm's length and not really forming relationships, realized she had strong feelings for Derick and the feeling was mutual.

Sometimes, Fiona would travel with the team, providing logistical and computer support from orbit as Derick and company would meet with local operatives or gather intelligence. ### *Field Work*

After initially saying no, wanting to stay at Pasture to continue her investigation into the incidents around both her parents and to help Derick with his recovery, it was Derick that convinced her to go.

The constant travel would open her up to infinite sources of information, and she'd also be better utilizing her skills to help end the Empire. It also meant that Fiona would be diving into deep cover situations, leaving her unable to contact her surrogate family at Pasture. She and Derick parted on nothing but the best of terms, pledging to let the other know when they could that they were okay, and a promise to meet on Coruscant when the galaxy was rid of the Empire.

### **Condensed Timeline:**

- **8 years old:** Tyria is killed
- **8 years old:** (6 months later) Pavik kidnapped, Fiona sent to live in a Corellian orphanage
- **16 years old:** Escapes the orphanage, stows away to Coruscant, finds and joins The Vortex
- **17 years old:** Digitally infiltrates Galactic Senate and CorSec for the first time, begins passing information along to the Rebel Alliance
- **20 years old:** Alliance handler pulls her off Coruscant after running afoul of Vortex leadership and puts her to work helping to build secret Alliance network
- **21 years old:** Ends up on Pasture, meets Derick Ralt for the first time
- **22 years old:** Begins romantic relationship with Derick and begins venturing out in the field assisting his team
- **24 years old:** Recruited to join new Alliance Strike Team as technology expert, leaves Pasture with a promise she'll meet Derick again
